For the first time in man's entire history, a simple way has been proving itself in the lives of many addicts. It is available to us all. This is a simple spiritual—not religious — program, known as Narcotics Anonymous.

NA is a non-profit fellowship or society of men and women for whom drugs had become a major problem. We are recovering addicts who meet regularly to help each other stay clean. Our program is a set of principles written so simply that we can follow them in our daily lives. The most important thing about them is that they work.
